

Curriculum Overview

Year 3 Spring

English

We will be writing a poem based on the Colour Collector as well as writing our own narrative based on 'The Book Eating Boy'. In reading, we will continue to work on our inference and prediction skills.

Maths

We will be securing our knowledge of the written method to solve addition and subtraction calculations as well as understanding unit and non unit fractions.

Science

Children will study plants, forces and magnets, whilst continuing to develop their scientific enquiry skills.

Computing

We will be looking at how to create media as well as programming using scratch.

History

Children will learn about the changes and developments that took place during the Stone Age.

Geography

Children will learn about different human and physical features in our city.

PSHE

Children will explore the themes 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Keeping Healthy'.

RE

We will explore the questions: 'Could Jesus heal people?' and 'What is 'Good' about Good Friday?'

Music

We will continue learning how to play the ukulele and look at the song 'Three Little Birds'. We will also be playing the recorder.

Art

Children will develop their sketching and painting skills and create their own Stone Age cave paintings.

Children will explore different food combinations to make their own fruit crumble.
