

Curriculum Overview

Year 4 Spring

English

Our narrative work this term will be based around the book 'Float. We will also create a scientific piece of writing based on the water cycle and study poetry.

Maths

We will be continuing our place value work by rounding up to 10 000. We will be calculating with fractions, decimals and money. We will also continue to improve our times tables knowledge in readiness for the MTC in June.

Science

Children will study the digestive system, electricity and develop their scientific enquiry skills.

Computing

We will be looking at programming using scratch and develop our computational thinking.

History

Children will learn about The Romans and what they did for us.

Geography

Children will learn about mountains and their geographical significance.

PSHE

Children will explore the themes 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Keeping Healthy'.

RE

Our Christianity unit will be based on Easter and our Judaism unit will be looking at Passover and how Jews show respect to God.

Music

Music this term will be based around the song 'Lean on Me'. We will also continue learning how to play the ukulele.

Art

Children will develop their drawing skills and use different media including clay.

D&T

Children will learn about electrical systems to design and make a working torch.

Spanish

We will extend our vocabulary to speak about ourselves and also explore Spanish grammar using a translation of 'Little Red Riding Hood'.
