

Curriculum Overview

Year 6 Spring

English

This term our narrative work will be based around the short film 'Alma'. We will also complete a poetry unit. In grammar, we will be helping the children to prepare for their SATs which take place in May.

Maths

We will be continuing our work on fractions, decimals and percentages and solving problems using different units of measure. We will continue to work on our arithmetic skills in readiness for SATs.

Science

Children will study inheritance and evolution over time, whilst developing their enquiry skills.

Computing

We will be looking at coding and the importance of cyber security.

History

Children will learn about the industrial achievements of The Victorians.

Geography

Children will learn about Antarctica and its geographical significance.

PSHE

Children will explore the themes 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Keeping Healthy'.

RE

We will explore the statement: 'What it means to live a good life as a Christian'

Music

Music this term will be based around the song 'You've got a friend'. We will also look at ensemble skills.

Art

Children will study Lowry and the use of perspective.

D&T

Children will complete a food technology unit to plan and prepare a three course meal.

Spanish

We will extend our vocabulary to include information about different types of homes and the weather.
