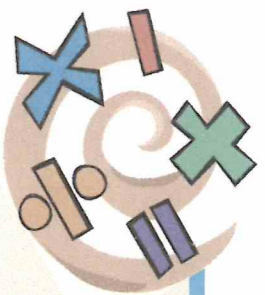
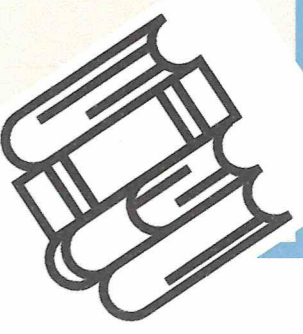


# YEAR THREE

## History:

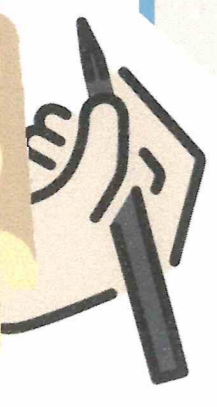
We will be looking into the history of our local area, researching significant events and people in the creation of the Birmingham we know today.
