Listed below is everything your child will learn about this term.

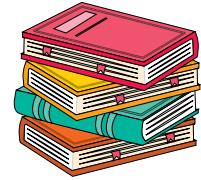
## ENGLISH

In English, we will continue our focus on narrative creating a narrative based on the book 'A Monster Calls' and rewriting our own versions of Hansel and Gretel with a twist!



## READING

We will be studying the book 'Holes' written by Louis Sachar. The children will use their inference skills to analyse characters in the book as well as making predictions and learning a range of new vocabulary.



## MATHS

When SATs are out of the way and we have finished our revision, we will move on to completing mathematical projects like costing and building a theme park as well as other investigations



## SCIENCE

We will be learning about how different animals are classified and how the Linnaean system works to help us do this.



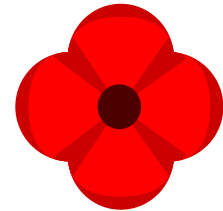
## HISTORY
