

Curriculum Overview

Year 3 Autumn

English

We will begin with a focus on grammar and punctuation, before moving onto writing our own instructions and a narrative. We will also be focusing on reading fluency, retrieval and vocabulary development.

Maths

We will be securing our place value work up to 1000. We will be calculating with all four operations and focus on our accuracy and speed during arithmetic sessions.

Science

Children will study forces and magnets, light and develop their scientific enquiry skills.

Computing

We will be looking at how to keep ourselves safe online, computer systems and emailing.

History

Children will learn about the remarkable achievements of the Ancient Egyptians.

Geography

Children will learn about different types of settlements and begin to use four figure grid references.

PSHE

Children will explore the themes 'Being me in my World' and 'Celebrating difference'.

RE

We will explore the questions: 'How does a Hindu feel during Diwali?' and 'Has Christmas lost its true meaning?'

Music

Pupils will be introduced to musical notation and begin to read musical notes. They will also sing as a choir to use their voices expressively.

Art

Children will develop their sculpting skills based on the Egyptian Gods.

D&T

Children will work with textiles to design and make their own cushion.

Spanish

We will learn classroom commands, days and months with a grammar focus on Spanish culture.

PE is on Monday. We are looking at netball and dance.
